

.LINK, .TATTOO, .SEXY, .PICS, .PHOTO, .CHRISTMAS, .BLACKFRIDAY, .GUITARS, .HIPHOP (the “Uniregistry TLDs”) – Terms and Conditions

In addition to your registration agreement, the Uniregistry TLDs Registry-Registrar Agreement (“RRA”) terms and conditions set out here shall apply. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of your registration agreement and the terms set out here, the RRA terms shall prevail.

1. Each registered name holder acknowledges and agrees that Uniregistry reserves the right to deny, cancel or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name(s) on registry lock, hold or similar status, as it deems necessary, in its unlimited and sole discretion: (i) to correct mistakes made by Uniregistry or any registrar in connection with a domain name registration, or (ii) for the non-payment of fees to Uniregistry.
2. Each registered name holder agrees to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Uniregistry and its subcontractors, and its and their directors, officers, employees, agents, and affiliates from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses, including reasonable legal fees and expenses arising out of or relating to, for any reason whatsoever, the registered name holder's domain name registration. This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination or expiration of the registration agreement.
3. All registered names holders agree to the following terms as a condition of purchasing and using a registered name in the Uniregistry TLDs:
 - a. Registered names allocated to registered names holders during any Uniregistry sunrise period are non-transferrable for the first ten (10) years after registration.
 - b. Registered name holders are prohibited in their use of their registered name, from distributing malware, abusively operating botnets, phishing, piracy, trademark or copyright infringement, fraudulent or deceptive practices, counterfeiting or otherwise engaging in activity contrary to applicable law, and providing (consistent with applicable law and any related procedures), and the consequences for such activities include suspension of their registered domain name.
4. All registered names holders agree to the following terms as a condition of purchasing and using a registered name in the .SEXY top-level domain:
 - a. For the .SEXY top-level domain, the registered names holder shall not permit content unsuitable for viewing by a minor to be viewed from the main or top-level directory of a .SEXY domain name. For purposes of clarity, content viewed at the main or top-level directory of a .SEXY domain name is the content immediately visible if a user navigates to <http://example.sexy> or <http://www.example.sexy>. No restrictions apply to the content at any other page or subdirectory addressed by a .SEXY registered name.
5. All registered name holders shall comply with Uniregistry’s Acceptable Use policies and Terms of Service, as they may be updated from time to time and published on the

Uniregistry website specific to the Uniregistry TLD for the registered name, and consistent with the registry agreement entered into between Uniregistry and ICANN (the “**Registry Agreement**”).

6. Each registrant in a Uniregistry TLD consents to the collection and use of personal data relating to itself.
7. All registered name holders shall comply with all ICANN consensus policies applicable to registered name holders, including (i) the Uniform Domain Name Dispute Resolution Policy (“UDRP”), as adopted by the ICANN Board of Directors on August 26, 1999; and (ii) the Inter-Registrar Transfer Policy, as adopted by the ICANN Board of Directors on November 12, 2004; and (iii) such other ICANN consensus policies as ICANN publishes on its website and makes applicable to Uniregistry, the registrar or the registered names holders.
8. Each registered name holder shall comply with each of the following requirements:
 - a. ICANN standards, policies, procedures, and practices for which Uniregistry has monitoring responsibility in accordance with the Registry Agreement or other arrangement with ICANN; and
 - b. Operational standards, policies, procedures, and practices for the Uniregistry TLDs established from time to time by Uniregistry in a non-arbitrary manner and applicable to all registrars (“**Operational Requirements**”), including affiliates of Uniregistry, and consistent with Uniregistry's Registry Agreement with ICANN, as applicable, upon Uniregistry's notification to the registrar of the establishment of those terms and conditions.
